RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 The Public Facilities and Transportation and Mobility Elements of the Staff Draft West
3 Hyattsville-Queens Chapel Sector Plan

4 For the purpose of identifying inconsistencies between the *Staff Draft West Hyattsville-Queens*
5 *Chapel Sector Plan* and existing or proposed State or County facilities, and approving the
6 inclusion of any new public facility proposals prior to the adoption of the sector plan by the
7 Prince George's County Planning Board of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning
8 Commission.

9 WHEREAS, Section 27-3502(f)(5) of the County Code requires the Prince George's
10 County Planning Board to submit its proposals for public facilities in the sector plan to the
11 County Executive and the County Council for identifying any inconsistencies between the staff
12 draft sector plan and existing or proposed State or County public facilities, including
13 transportation improvements, and in the event of any inconsistencies the District Council shall
14 direct the Planning Board on how the inconsistencies shall be eliminated or accommodated
15 within the sector plan; and

16 WHEREAS, after consultation with the County Executive, the District Council may also
17 approve, by resolution, public facilities and transportation improvements proposed by the
18 Planning Board for inclusion in the adopted sector plan; and

19 WHEREAS, on July 28, 2022, the Planning Board transmitted the public facilities element
20 of the *Staff Draft West Hyattsville-Queens Chapel Sector Plan* for review and comments as to
21 any public facilities inconsistencies, and for approval of the inclusion of proposed transportation

1 improvements for planning purposes; and

2 WHEREAS, after referral by the Planning Board to the County Executive for comments on
3 the public facilities element of the Staff Draft of the Sector Plan, the District Council finds that
4 no comments identifying inconsistencies between the proposed staff draft plan and existing State
5 or County public facilities submitted by the County Executive; and

6 WHEREAS, the District Council finds that, in general, the new and modified public
7 facilities, including transportation proposals, contained in the *Staff Draft West Hyattsville-*
8 *Queens Chapel Sector Plan* are consistent with the current Maryland Department of
9 Transportation Consolidated Transportation Program (CTP), Maryland-National Capital Park
10 and Planning Commission Capital Improvement Program (CIP), and Prince George's County
11 CIP; and

12 WHEREAS, the District Council further recognizes that the sector plan is a long-range plan
13 with certain planning proposals intended for implementation over a time period that exceeds the
14 five- to six-year timeframe captured in the current Maryland Department of Transportation CTP,
15 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission CIP, and Prince George's County
16 CIP, respectively.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
18 County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington
19 Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the transportation and public
20 facilities improvements proposed in the transportation and mobility and public facilities elements
21 for the *Staff Draft West Hyattsville-Queens Chapel Sector Plan*, as transmitted on July 28, 2022,
22 by the Prince George's County Planning Board, are hereby approved for inclusion in the staff
23 draft sector plan.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as authorized within the local zoning laws of the
25 County, it is the intent of the District Council to further examine the sector plan and public
26 facilities element upon its receipt of the adopted sector plan from the Planning Board and may, at
27 that time, consider certain revisions to the sector plan and its transportation and public facilities
28 systems as deemed necessary, consistent with the plan record and with County long-range goals
29 and objectives.
