Operating and Capital Budgets of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC).			
WHEREAS, during the Fiscal Year 1994 Bi-County budget process the Montgomery and			
Prince George's County Councils established a Bi-County Working Group to recommend			
changes that woul	d control the growth of debt and maintain future rate increases at WSSC close		
to the level of infl	ation; and		
WHEREAS, the Working Group's January 1994 Report recommended the establishment of			
a spending affordability process; and			
WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council endorsed the entire Working Group's			
report through the adoption of CR-12-1994 and the Montgomery Council endorsed part			
of the report's recommendations through Resolution #12-1558; and			
WHEREAS,	the Councils jointly endorsed in concept the January 1994 Working Group		
Report spending affordability process; and			
WHEREAS,	both Councils endorsed the utilization of the spending affordability process		
beginning with the formulation of the Fiscal Year 1996 budget; and			
WHEREAS, the Spending Affordability Working Group, consisting of the staffs of the			
Montgomery and Prince George's County Councils and both County Executive's offices, make			
certain recommendations on the WSSC Fiscal Year 2024 Operating and Capital Budgets; and			

1	WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council and the Montgomery County Council			
2	have reviewed the information compiled by the staff relating to spending control limits on the			
3	percentage of water and sewer increase; new debt; debt service and operating expenditures; and			
4	WHEREAS, on October 24, 2022, the County Council Sitting as the Committee of the			
5	Whole discussed the spending control limits for WSSC's FY 2024 Capital and Operating			
6	Budgets.
