## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:**

The proposed legislation will require new residential dwellings to build the infrastructure for electric vehicle (EV) charging ports. Similar legislation was enacted in Frederick County (Chapter 1-6) and Howard County (CB-76-2018).
