PROCEEDINGS

CHAIRMAN SHAPIRO: And we will now go to Item 5 on the agenda. Item 5 is the Comprehensive Design Plan CDP-9901-01 Forest Hills. Let me read into the record our procedures for this comprehensive design plan hearing. I'm going to be doing this as we move forward. And I have a well-drafted set of procedures from staff.

So this hearing is being held under the general enabling authority of the Land Use Article Annotated Code of Maryland and conducted in accordance with the specific requirements and procedures of Sections 27-516 through 27-532 of the Prince George's County Code and the Maryland Administrative Procedures Act.

The purpose of this hearing is to consider the applicant's submission of a comprehensive design plan proposal and to consider the plan in relation to the criteria set forth in Section 27-521 of the Prince George's County Code. All persons who wish to participate in the hearing must register with the Planning Board aide at this time if you have not already done so. I believe you all have done so. I also want to swear in any folks who are speaking.

Actually before I do this, I know we're in midprocess, but Commissioner Doerner, staff asked that we clarify which is the call-in number that you have because

1 there's another call-in number as well. 2 Ryan, what do you need Commissioner 3 Doerner to do here? We're testing which phone is his? 4 RYAN CRAUN: No, we're actually good. We 5 understand which phone is his now. 6 CHAIRMAN SHAPIRO: All right. The problem's been 7 resolved, Commissioner Doerner. You don't have to worry about it. We're good to go. 9 COMMISSIONER DOERNER: Okay. 10 CHAIRMAN SHAPIRO: Okay. So then all persons who 11 are appearing before the Board to present testimony in this 12 matter must be sworn in. 13 Mr. Balian, that's you. Is there anyone else? 14 MR. BALIAN: No, that's just me. 15 CHAIRMAN SHAPIRO: Just you. So if you could 16 raise your right hand. 17 Do you solemnly promise and declare that the 18 testimony you're about to give before this Board is the 19 truth to the best of your knowledge and belief? 20 MR. BALIAN: I do. 21 CHAIRMAN SHAPIRO: Okay. You are sworn in. So 22 with that, we're going to start with staff. Ms. Kosack, I think this is -- I don't think we 23 24 have an issue, but I think there's been a whole lot of work 25 that's been done behind the scene on this, and staff and the applicant are in agreement. We don't have anyone who signed up to speak in opposition to this. So I'll turn it over to staff for a very brief presentation, and then we'll provide the opportunity for the applicant to say anything as well.

Ms. Kosack, take it away.

MS. KOSACK: Yes, good morning, Mr. Chair and members of the Planning Board. For the record, I am Jill Kosack with Urban Design Section. Item number 5 is CDP-9901-01 Comprehensive Design Plan for Forest Hills which seeks to amend the conditions and plans to reflect the changes made by the Zoning Map Amendment A-9895-C-01 relative to the removal of the Western Branch Trail through the west side of the property.

Based on evaluation and analysis, Urban Design staff recommends the Planning Board to adopt the findings of this report and approve CDP-9901-01 and Type 1 Tree Conservation Plan TCP1-064-95-03 for Forest Hills subject to just one condition found on page 12 of the staff report. And if it is the pleasure of the Board to make a motion, this would conclude staff's presentation.

CHAIRMAN SHAPIRO: Thank you, Ms. Kosack, for your efficiency on that.

Mr. Balian, anything you want to add? Good to see you again by the way.

MR. BALIAN: Likewise. Members of the Planning

Board and Mr. Chairman, this process has taken a few years 1 2 to get to this point. We'd worked with the Parks Department 3 extensively. We're basically moving the trail from the 4 Western Branch which is on the west side of the property. 5 And we are providing a fee-in-lieu to the Parks Department 6 as they wished to connect certain trails on the east side of 7 the property where Beechtree and several other developments have built trails, but have not been connected. 9 The trail on the west side was going from nowhere to nowhere, whereas the funds that we will be providing to 10 11 the Parks Department will connect several trails and serve 12 the greater good to Prince George's County. So I'm glad 13 that we have gotten to this point. We've had several 14 hearings at the district council with the zoning hearing 15 examiner, and here we are just to make an amendment to the 16 CDP to reflect all the changes we've made to get to this 17 point. With that, I conclude my presentation. 18 CHAIRMAN SHAPIRO: Thank you, Mr. Balian. 19 Commissioners, any questions for staff or Mr. 20 Balian? No questions. And there's no one else to speak for us, so our hearing is closed, and I'll turn it over to 21 22 Commissioners. What's your pleasure? 23 24 MR. WARNER: Excuse me, Mr. Shapiro,
