Additional requirements for Specific Special Exception Uses. 3 (kkk) Tobacco shops, electronic cigarette shops or a retail tobacco business (1) Tobacco shops, electronic cigarette shops, or a retail tobacco business may be 4 5 permitted by special exception, subject to the following: 6 The structure in which the use is proposed shall be located at least three (A) 7 hundred (300) feet from any school, library, park, recreational facility, and 8 historic site, resource, or district identified on any applicable Historic Sites 9 and District Plan, a National Register Site, or an Historic District. This 10 provision shall not apply to a retail tobacco or electronic cigarette business 11 within a recreational or entertainment establishment of a commercial nature 12 with video lottery facility uses in accordance with Section 27-5102(e)(7)(D), Recreational or Entertainment Establishment of a Commercial Nature with a 13 14 Video Lottery Facility, of this Subtitle. In its final decision to approve a special exception for the use, the Council 15 (B) 16 may impose other reasonable requirements deemed necessary to safeguard the 17 health, safety, morals, and general welfare of the community, taking into 18 account the character of surrounding properties and the general neighborhood, 19 and any other uses on the subject property. 20 No special exception shall be permitted for a tobacco shop, electronic (C) 21 cigarette shop, or a retail tobacco business located within 2,000 feet of 22 another tobacco shop, electronic cigarette shop, or a retail tobacco business. 23 In addition, the use shall be limited to specified daily hours of operation, 24 which shall be between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. This provision 25 shall not apply to a Retail Tobacco Business within a Recreational or 26 Entertainment Establishment of a Commercial Nature with Video Lottery 27 Facility uses. 28 (D) Any displays or signs with LED, bright, flashing lights, or any lights 29 prohibited pursuant to Section 27-61503, are not permitted. Other illuminated 30 displays or signs shall only be limited to the hours of operation for the use which shall be no earlier than 10:00 a.m. and no later than 8:00 p.m. 31

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that to provide for a reasonable period of
amortization and to prevent unreasonable economic loss, any existing Tobacco shop, electronic
cigarette shop or retail tobacco business uses in all zones except for IH as of December 31,2023,
may not be deemed compliant and must cease operations on or before December 31, 2025.
SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Ordinance are
hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph,
subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is declared invalid or
unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall
not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs,
subsections, or sections of this Ordinance of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase,
clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.
SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five
(45) calendar days after its adoption.
