1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 Nonresidential and Mixed-Use Form and Design Standards—Donation Containers

3 For the purpose of amending the Nonresidential and Mixed Use Form and Design Standards of  
 4 the Zoning Ordinance to prohibit placement of donation boxes for collection of household and  
 5 personal items on the exterior property areas and associated parking areas.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
 14 Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional  
 15 District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 27-16002 of the Zoning Ordinance of  
 16 Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code,  
 17 be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

18 **SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.**19 **PART 27-6. DESIGN STANDARDS.**20 **SECTION 27-61000. NONRESIDENTIAL AND MIXED-USE FORM AND DESIGN**

**STANDARDS.**

**Sec. 27-61002. Nonresidential and Mixed-Use Form and Design Standards.**

Development subject to this Section shall comply with the following standards.

**(k) Exterior Donation Containers Prohibited.**

Freestanding donation containers for the collection of household and personal items for collection by a third-party are prohibited on the exterior of the subject property and associated parking areas that serve the development.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after its adoption.
