FOR the purpose	e of granting a renewal of a franchise for the operation of a cable television
system in the No	orthern and Southern Territories of Prince George's County (the "County")
and prescribing of	certain terms and conditions to be included in a franchise agreement.
WHEREAS	S, pursuant to Section 5A-102(d)(l) of the Prince George's County Code, (the
"County Code")	the County Council has established, by adoption of Council Resolution
CR-2-1980, the l	poundaries of a Northern and a Southern Territory for the grant of franchises
for the operation	of cable television systems within the County; and
WHEREAS	S, by Council Bill CB-17-1999, the County Council granted a renewal of a
franchise (the "H	Existing Comcast Franchise Agreement") awarded to Jones Communications of
Maryland, Inc., a	a Colorado corporation and predecessor in interest to Comcast of Maryland, LLC
(the "Franchisee"	") to provide cable services within the County; and
WHEREAS	S, the Existing Comcast Franchise Agreement was for a term of fifteen (15)
years and the Co	unty and Franchisee desire renewal thereof for an additional ten (10) years; and
WHEREAS	S, the cable franchise renewal process is governed by the Federal Cable Act,
47 U.S.C. §546,	et seq., which sets forth both an informal and formal process for renewal; and
WHEREAS	S, after negotiations, the Franchisee and the County have agreed, pursuant to
applicable law, o	on the terms and conditions of a new franchise agreement (the "Franchise
Agreement"), su	bstantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A; and
WHEREAS	S, pursuant to Section 5A-1113(c) of the County Code, the Prince George's

County Cable Television Commission (the "Cable Commission") has reviewed the financial, technical, legal, and character qualifications of the Franchisee and has forwarded to the County Council its recommendation for approval of the renewal of a franchise for the operation of a cable television system in the Northern and Southern Territories of the County, subject to the terms and conditions of the Franchise Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Section 5A-119(g) of the County Code provides that County Council shall have the sole authority renew franchises; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that renewal of the nonexclusive right to construct and operate a cable television system along the public rights-of-way of the County within the Northern and Southern Territories as established in Council Resolution CR-21-1980, be and the same is hereby granted to Comcast of Maryland, LLC.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the franchise renewal granted under this Act shall be subject to the terms and conditions of the Franchise Agreement.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to enter into the Franchise Agreement with the Franchisee evidencing the renewal of the franchise under this Act and the Franchisee's acceptance of the same. The Franchise Agreement shall bind the Franchisee to fulfill the requirements set forth in the Franchise Agreement.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the County Executive is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to make any modifications, deletions, corrections or other changes to complete any further negotiations on the Franchise Agreement in any manner in which the County may deem necessary to complete the transaction but as will not alter the substance of the Franchise Agreement.

SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) days after it becomes law.
