5	owned by the Redevelopment Authority of Prince George's County or acquired from the
6	Redevelopment Authority pursuant to a redevelopment agreement AND WHICH FRONTS
7	EITHER CENTRAL AVENUE/EAST CAPITOL STREET (MD 214) OR OLD CENTRAL
8	AVENUE/CENTRAL AVENUE (MD 332) BETWEEN THE COUNTY'S BOUNDARY WITH
9	THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA AND LANDOVER ROAD/LARGO ROAD (MD 202), the
