1. Please provide a list of County based and MBE firms participating in the Clean Water Partnership and other related stormwater programs.

2. What is the desired number of cameras needed to cover critical illegal dumping sites within the County and the estimated cost? Is there a related timeline or phase-in plan for these covert cameras?

The desired number of cameras at this point are to be determined. The Department has deployed surveillance and will collect data on the outcomes of the program.

3. Please provide data on the increased costs associated with increased placement at ASD?

This year, ASD has seen a 55% increase in the purchase of supplies and veterinarian services. This, however, is due more to a global cost increase post the pandemic.

4. Please provide placement rates of animals coming into the division for FY21, FY22, FY23 expected, and FY24 proposed if you have a proposed rate.

- 5. Please provide what programs or initiatives the Department is facilitating to allow residents to dispose of their scrap tires, thus reducing the illegal dumping of these waste items.
 - Residents are allowed to bring old/scrap tires to the landfill Monday through Saturday, at no charge.
 - Residents may schedule tire(s) curbside pick-up by contacting PGC311.
 - When the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) offers scrap tire collection funding to counties, the Resource Recovery Division (RRD) utilizes that funding to hold special scrap tire collection community events for residents and the agricultural (farmers) sector.
- 6. Please outline the challenges of a vehicular tire identification program. If tires are part of a civil or criminal act, does that not nullify any privacy concerns that could be a legal barrier in identifying the criminal that dumped the tires?

Any tire identification program would be under the jurisdiction of the Maryland Department of the Environment.

7. Does the Department have any strategy or future plans to facilitate the creation of community solar farms, especially for disadvantaged communities that may not own their homes, or may not have the capital to have solar panels installed on their roofs?

This is currently to be determined. However, it is currently under discussion in the Climate Action Implementation Task Force. No funding is currently allocated to implementation of community solar outside of the Energy Resiliency Communities (ERCs).

8. Please provide a breakdown of acreage treated according to program area of March 2023.

The number reported under DPWT Inlet and Street Sweeping (Operational Program) is an <u>average annual Impervious Surface Restoration (ISR)</u> of 207.41 through FY 2022 (Source FY 2022 NPDES MS4 Annual Report).
