A RESOLUTION concerning

Contract Approvals

For the purpose of approving various multiyear contracts for the Office of Information Technology.

WHEREAS, Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George's County, Maryland, requires that the County Council approve, by Resolution, multiyear contracts exceeding an aggregate of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter for Prince George's County, Maryland no agency of the County Government shall, during any fiscal year, expend any money or incur any liability in excess of the amounts appropriated and no such payment shall be made, nor any obligation or liability incurred, except for purchases in an amount to be fixed by legislative act;

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into contracts with various vendors for software products, Geographic Information System (GIS) license and hosting, audio visual modernization, security operations and software, IT hardware, consultant and technical services, digitization, data center hosting, desk and telecommunication services; and

WHEREAS, the contracts between Prince George's County, Maryland and the various identified vendors will be conducted pursuant to the terms and conditions contained herein as Attachments A through L.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the agreement as described in Attachments A through L pursuant to Section 819 of the Prince George's County Charter be and the same are hereby APPROVED.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive is hereby authorized to make

such necessary modifications, adjustments, corrections, or any other changes as may be necessary, to finalize the subject agreements in any manner the County Executive may deem necessary or proper but not altering its substance.
