





KEY QUESTIONS








- What are the feasible and complementary opportunities to transit-oriented development at the area's Local Centers?

- How does the community envision the future use of the FedExField property?
- What are the appropriate recommendations for the rezoning of properties within the sector plan boundary?




- Recognize and build off the wealth of knowledge from prior plans, studies, and community input efforts.
