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1 PROCEEDINGS 2 (Beginning of designation) 3 MR. CHAIR: Item 12 is DSP-22028, Fairwood Square. 4 We have Mr. Tedesco representing the applicant. Although, 5 let me get to my notes on this. We have Mr. Shelly. 6 Mr. Shelly right in front of me. Thank you. 7 MR. SHELLY: Thank you, Chair Shapiro. MR. CHAIR: So I believe we have a preliminary 8 9 matter on this. Mr. Shelly, you want to tee us off and then 10 we'll turn to Mr. Tedesco? 11 MR. SHELLY: Yes. Good morning, Mr. Chair and 12 members of the planning board. For the record, I'm Andrew 13 Shelly with the urban design department or urban design 14 section. Item number 12 is detailed site plan DSP-22028 for 15 Fairwood Square, which seeks to develop 200 single-family 16 attached townhouse dwelling units and infrastructure for the 17 future development of approximately 5,000 square feet of 18 commercial/retail uses on Parcel 1. The applicant has 19 requested a two-week continuance until April 13th, 2023. 20 And staff recommends that the planning board approve the 21 two-week continuance. This would conclude staff's 22 presentation. Thank you. MR. CHAIR: Thank you, Mr. Shelly. 23 24 Mr. Tedesco, you want to step in on this?

MR. TEDESCO: Yeah. Just I think a point of

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order. The requested continuance actually came from a citizen opponent, Mr. Michael Bridges, that we got word of this morning. I believe it was filed yesterday. So notwithstanding the filing coming in after the Tuesday deadline, and not conceding the basis for the continuance, which was a referral that was received by DPIE on the 23rd of March. Not conceding that that is, quote/unquote, new information under Section 27-125.05(a). In the abundance of caution, the applicant is in agreement with the staff's suggested two-week continuance in response to Mr. Bridge's request for a one-week continuance.

MR. CHAIR: Thank you.

Mr. Hunt, how does this affect the action limit and is there anything specific we need to do related to that?

MR. HUNT: At this point in time, the applicant would need to waive on the record, which I think they are willing to do so, the action limit. Because today is the action limit at this point in time from my understanding.

MR. TEDESCO: Yeah. Actually, just a point of clarification. You might recall, Mr. Chairman, that last week we continued this case to today --

MR. CHAIR: Right.

MR. TEDESCO: -- based upon an error on the commission's website. And at that time, I did waive the

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    action period to April 15th. So as I understand it, the
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    hearing would be on April 13th. I don't believe that
    requires another waiver since it's within the action period.
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    But if it's deemed necessary from either Mr. Hunt or from
