## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:**

This Resolution will direct staff of the Prince George's County Planning Board of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission to prepare, in accordance with the provisions of the County Zoning Ordinance, a minor amendment to the *Approved 2009 Countywide Master Plan of Transportation* to amend the Plan *STRATEGIES* and to revise "Map 27" to remove any symbology pertaining to a Planned Freeway or Planned Interchange impacting certain properties. If adopted, the Resolution also sets the public hearing date for the proposed minor amendment specified herein. Upon initiation, the minor amendment will be subject to a joint public hearing to take public testimony and comments on the proposed minor amendment as required by law.
