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**REPORT:** Favorable 3-0: Council Members Burroughs, Harrison and Oriadha.

The Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee met on September 14, 2023, to consider the County Executive nominee to the Personnel Board. The Personnel Board plays a vital role in interpreting and adjudicating Personnel law, County regulations, and administrative policies, all of which are critical to the proper and efficient operation of County government.

Ms. Miriam Brewer, Appointment Liaison, Office of the County Executive, provided an overview of the qualifications of the reappointee to the Personnel Board, Ms. Bridgette Ann Greer, after which Ms. Greer provided information on her background and her desire to serve on the Personnel Board.

Ms. Greer, a resident of Bowie, retired from Prince George's County Government after thirty-three (33) years of service. She was Special Assistant to the County Attorney and Senior Attorney under the general direction of the County Attorney. She has in-depth experience in employment law, having served as Deputy Director of the Office of Human Resources Management (OHRM). She received her undergraduate degree from Kean College of New Jersey and her Juris Doctor degree from Rutgers University School of Law. Ms. Greer has Bar Admissions in the United States District Court of Maryland, the Court of Appeals of Maryland, the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, the United States District Court of New Jersey, and the Supreme Court of New Jersey.

After discussion, the Government Operations Fiscal Policy Committee voted the nominees to the Personnel Board out favorably 3 – 0.
