WHEREAS	, Section 29-120.01 of the Prince George's County Code provides a process for		
the owner(s) of a	n historic property to petition for designation as an historic site with the Prince		
George's County	Historic Preservation Commission; and		
WHEREAS	, the Yates and Mary Boswell House, located at 6500 40st Avenue, University		
Park, is significa	nt as a substantially intact example of early twentieth century domestic		
architecture in th	e Town of University Park, the Yates and Mary Boswell House and its 0.24-acre		
Environmental S	etting meets HPC Historic Site designation criteria (1)(A)(iv), (2)(A)(i),		
(2)(A)(ii), and (2)(A)(v), and therefore could be designated as a Historic Site and included in the		
Inventory of Hist	oric Sites; and		
WHEREAS	, this property is a representative example of its type, period of construction,		
and location; and			
WHEREAS	, in accordance with the provisions of Sec. 29-120.01, the property owners,		
Darragh and Emi	ly McNally, filed a petition with the Historic Preservation Commission for		
designation of the	eir property as a historic site; and		
WHEREAS	, after proper posting and notice was given as required by law, the Prince		

George's County Historic Preservation Commission held a public hearing on September 19,

2023; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission recommended that the Yates and Mary Boswell House (Documented Property 66-029-09) and its 0.24-acre Environmental Setting (Lot 1 of Block 21, "Section 5A University Park"), be designated as a historic site based on the designation criteria described above; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the District Council, held a joint public hearing on the significance of this property with the Prince George's County Planning Board on January 16, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the record of the hearing was left open until 5:00 p.m. on January 31, 2024; and no additional testimony was received, and

WHEREAS, on February 15, 2024, the Prince George's County Planning Board voted to recommend that the Yates and Mary Boswell House be designated as an Historic Site; and

WHEREAS, on March 5, 2024, in accordance with provisions of the local laws, the District Council convened as the Committee of the Whole to review the transcript analysis and Planning Board recommendation as to the proposed designation and, after discussion, favorably voted to direct the staff to prepare a Resolution of Approval as to the proposed Historic Site Designation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Yates and Mary Boswell House (Documented Property 66-029-09) and its 0.24-acre Environmental Setting (Lot 1 of Block 21, "Section 5A University Park"), is hereby designated as an Historic Site in Prince George's County, Maryland.
