1	(a) Contractor means a contractor having a written contract with the County for the
2	provision of services, including construction and construction management services, as defined
3	by Sec. 10A-101(12) of the Prince George's County Code, shall not, during the performance of
4	the contract, through its employees or agents, engage in human sex trafficking or human labor
5	trafficking as defined by Sec. 14-191, Subtitle 14 of The Prince George's County Code.
6	Sec. 2-231.10 – Filing a Complaint
7	(a) Filing Complaints. If any person believes that a Contractor or a Contractor's employees
8	or agents does not comply with the prohibitions against human sex trafficking and human
9	labor trafficking set forth in Sec. 14-191, Subtitle 14, of The Prince George's County
10	Code, they may file a complaint with the Office of Human Rights.
11	(b) Complaint Requirement. A complaint under this Section must:
12	(1) be filed under oath;
13	(2) include the particulars of the alleged violation, the name and address of the
14	Contractor alleged to have committed the violation as set forth in Sec. 14-191,
15	Subtitle 14, of the Prince George's County Code, and
16	(3) any other information required by the Office of Human Rights.
17	(c) Dismissal. If after an investigation by the Office of Human Rights, the Contractor is
18	found to have not been in violation of the prohibitions against human sex trafficking and
19	human labor trafficking in, the Office of Human Rights must dismiss the complaint and
20	mail copies of its findings to the Respondent-Contractor, the Complainant, and the Office
21	of Central Services.
22	(d) Non-Compliance Penalty. If after an investigation by the Office of Human Rights, the
23	Contractor is found to be in violation of the prohibition against human sex trafficking and
24	human labor trafficking as set forth in Sec. 14-191, Subtitle 14, the Office of Human
25	Rights shall refer this decision to the Office of Central Services, whereby the Office of
26	Central Services shall initiate suspension and debarment proceedings pursuant to Sec.
27	10A-148 and consider any other relief available to the Office of Central Services,
28	including but not limited to, contract termination and breach of contract damages.
29	(e) Criminal Prosecution. An investigation or finding made by the Office of Human Rights
30	under this Section is not intended to preclude a criminal investigation or criminal
31	prosecution by the State's Attorney's Office or any law enforcement agency.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby 19 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, 20 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of 21 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining 22 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this 23 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such 24 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section. 25 26 SECTION 3.
