For the purpose of approving a full waiver of the public safety facilities surcharge for all					
esidential units w	rithin "The Highlands" project.				
WHEREAS,	in Council Bill 89-2004, the County Executive of Prince George's County and				
he County Counc	til enacted an amendment to section 24-122.01 of the Prince George's County				
Code, to impose a	n adequate facilities surcharge for new residential construction in the County;				
and					
WHEREAS, consistent with the requirements of Chapter 594 of the Laws of Maryland					
2005 (House Bill 1129), codified as Section 10-192.11 of the Prince George's County Code, the					
County Executive	and County Council approved Council Bill 56-2005 to modify the				
requirements of C	B 89-2004; and				
WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 461 of the 2020 Laws of Maryland and Section					
10.192.11(a) of the Prince George's County Code, the governing body of Prince George's					
County, by resolu	tion, may impose a public safety surcharge on new residential construction for				
which a building p	permit is issued by the County; and				
WHEREAS, Section 10-192.11(b)(3) of the Prince George's County Code authorizes the					
County Council, acting as the governing body of Prince George's County, to waive any					

surcharge imposed within the Transportation Service Area 1, as defined by the National-Capital

WHEREAS, The Highlands will be located on Sherriff Road, adjacent to the First Baptist

Park and Planning Commission in the Prince George's County approved General Plan; and

Church of Highland Park in the Landover area of Prince George's County; and

WHEREAS, The Highlands will consist of 137-unit, age-restricted (62+), of affordable housing development with over 132 apartments restricted to tenants earning 60% AMI and 5 units restricted to tenants earning 50% AMI. The property will consist of 89 one and 48 two-bedroom units; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has determined, because The Highlands will have many positive effects on the residential environment in the Landover area, that the public safety facilities surcharge required under CB-55-2005 and CB-56-2005 should be reduced by 100% for the building permits that will be issued; and will for the foreseeable future, be more than adequately served by the police and fire facilities; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution, subject to the County Council approval, will complete the process required for the full waiver of the public safety facilities surcharge for The Highlands project; and

WHEREAS, any surcharge imposed within the Transportation Service Area 1 may be waived by the County Executive and County Council, acting as the governing body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the public safety facilities surcharge shall be fully waived for The Highlands.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the public safety facilities surcharge required in CB-55-2005 and CB-56-2005 is hereby fully waived for The Highlands project, and building permits that will be issued to the Developer for the dwelling units shall not be subject to the applicable public safety facilities surcharge.
