CR-026-2024 is a resolution concerning contract approvals for the purpose of approving certain multiyear contracts in accordance with the Prince George's County Charter and Subtitle 10 of the Prince George's County Code. Specifically, multi-year contracts exceeding an aggregate of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for goods and services, as well as multiyear personal service contracts exceeding an aggregate of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), must be presented for public review, comment, and approval action by the County Council.

In response to questions about the contract for trash collection, Department of Environment (DOE) Director, Andrea Crooms, provided information about the ways DOE makes the contractors perform more efficiently and confirmed all the trash contractors are based in Prince George's County. Regarding complaints about the service, Director Crooms stated DOE investigates, meets with the contractor, and, if necessary, issues fines.

After further discussion, the Committee of the Whole voted no recommendation 8-0.
