On behalf of the Prince George's County Planning Board, I appreciate the opportunity to comment on the 2023 Parks and Recreation Facilities Guidelines.

On July 18, 2024, the Department of Parks and Recreation staff briefed the Planning Board on the updated Parks and Recreation Facilities Guidelines. This comprehensive document was updated to be consistent with *Formula 2040* and is meant to serve as a companion resource to the current Subdivision Regulations and Zoning Ordinance. The Parks and Recreation Facilities Guidelines provide the foundation for the Development Community to develop public and private outdoor recreation facilities in Prince George's County.
