WHEREAS, the County	Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the			
District Council for that part	of the Maryland-Washington Metropolitan Regional District in			
Prince George's County, Mar	ryland, adopted CB-6-2007 on May 22, 2007, and CB-5-2010 on			
April 27, 2010, respectively;	and			
WHEREAS, on July 9,	2007, CB-6-2007 took effect and became Chapter No. 5 of the 2007			
Laws of Prince George's Cou	anty, Maryland; and			

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WHEREAS, on June 11, 2010, CB-5-2010 took effect and became Chapter No.4 of the 2010 laws of Prince George's County, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, Chapter No. 5 of the 2007 Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland, amended Section 27-547(b) of the Zoning Ordinance to permit limited industrial uses in the M-X-T zone under certain circumstances; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Chapter No. 4 of the 2010 Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland, further provided that its provisions would terminate and be of no further force and effect after July 9, 2012; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to extend the time for abrogation of the provisions of Chapter No. 4 of the 2010 Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland; now, therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 27-547(b) of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted without amendments:
