RESOLUTION

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 An Executive Pay Plan

3 For the purpose of approving additional compensation benefits for the Police Chief.

4 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Charter provides in Section 402(5) for the County
5 Executive to prepare an Executive Pay Plan establishing compensation for the head of each
6 agency of the Executive Branch subject to the approval of the County Council; and

7 WHEREAS, Section 903 of the Prince George's County Charter provides for the approval
8 of Pay Plans by the County Council after having first been submitted by the County Executive;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, by Council Resolutions CR-179-1985, CR-4-1986, and CR-77-1986 the
11 County has previously established salary, leave and benefits for exempt service employees of the
12 County, including department heads; and

13 WHEREAS, CR-179-1985 provides that any additional compensation shall require
14 recommendation by the County Executive and submission to the County Council for approval by
15 Resolution; and

16 WHEREAS, by Council Resolution CR-50-1995 the Council has approved additional
17 compensation for the Police Chief; and

18 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended to the County Council certain
19 additional compensation for the Police Chief;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's
2 County, Maryland, that the additional compensation proposed by the County Executive for the
3 Police Chief be and the same is hereby approved as follows:

4 Additional compensation in the amount of \$14,000 per annum, paid in bi-weekly
5 increments beginning on April 12, 1999; additional compensation in the form of payment to a
6 non-qualified deferred compensation or annuity plan [IRC 457(f)], said payment to be in the
7 amount of \$25,000 per annum, for each year of service after January 1, 1999 through
8 December 31, 2002.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective on the date of its
10 adoption.
