WHEREAS,	the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the
District Council fo	or that part of the Maryland-Washington Metropolitan Regional District in
Prince George's C	County, Maryland, adopted CB-3-2012 on December 6, 2012; and
WHEREAS,	CB-3-2012 became effective on December 6, 2012, as Chapter No. 78, 2012
Laws of Prince Go	eorge's County, Maryland; and
WHEREAS,	Section 1 of Chapter No. 78 of the 2012 Laws of Prince George's County,
Maryland, made c	ertain changes to Section 27-230 of the Zoning Ordinance for Prince George's
County concernin	g approval of certain variances; and
WHEREAS,	Section 2 of Chapter No. 78 added Sections 27-1801 through 27-1810 of the
Zoning Ordinance	e, thereby developing new development standards and procedures, such as the
establishment and	imposition of temporary zoning requirements for development of properties in
the vicinity of Join	nt Base Andrews for an established period of time; and

1	WHEREAS, Section 5 of Chapter No. 78 provides that the provisions of this Ordinance
2	shall be abrogated and no longer effective twelve (12) months after adoption; and
3	WHEREAS, Section 5 of Chapter No. 78 further provides the time for abrogation may be
4	extended one time by approval of the District Council for a period of six months; and
5	WHEREAS, there is a need to extend the time for abrogation of the provisions of Chapter
6	No. 78 of the 2012 Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland; and
7	WHEREAS, the District Council has considered and finds that a six-month extension of the
8	Interim Land Use Control Ordinance in Chapter No. 78, 2012 Laws of Prince George's County,
9	Maryland, is appropriate; now, therefore
10	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
11	Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional
12	District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Section 5 of Chapter No. 78, 2012 Laws
13	of Prince George's County, Maryland, be amended to read as follows:
