**BILL**

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Drug Free Zone Signage in County Facilities

3 For the purpose of requiring signage at County Facilities denoting that it is a Drug Free Zone.

 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
 16 Maryland, that Sections 14-164, 14-165 and 14-166 of the Prince George's County Code be and  
 17 the same are hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

18 SUBTITLE 14. MORALS AND CONDUCT.

19 DIVISION 12. CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that Section 14-166.01 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby added:

**Subdivision 2. COUNTY BUILDING AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES**

**Sec. 14-166.01. Signage.**

(a) All County facilities including, but not limited to, buildings, recreational facilities as well as facilities of the Prince George's County Library System, Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission and the Health Department, shall have signs that contain language or symbols that the building and surrounding County property is designated as a drug free zone. The signs shall be displayed conspicuously at the entrance of each County facility.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
