A RESOLUTION concerning		
Job Access and Reverse Commute and New Freedom Programs		
For the purpose of authorizing and approving the filing of an application with the Maryland		
Transit Administration of the Maryland Department of Transportation for an FY 2014 and FY		

2015 grant under Title 49 U.S.C. 5316, as amended by SAFETEA-LU – Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) and Section 5317 – New Freedom Programs under the Federal Transit Act.

WHEREAS, § 2-103(i) of the Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that the State Secretary of Transportation may apply for and receive from the federal government grants for any transportation related purpose, and may make grants to any

governmental transportation agency, including any local, county or municipal agency; and WHEREAS, § 7-204(e) of the Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that the Maryland Transit Administration may apply for and receive grants from the

federal government and may enter into agreements for them; and

WHEREAS, under Title 49 U.S.C. 5316, as amended by SAFETEA-LU, the Maryland Transit Administration is the eligible designated recipient in Maryland for grants under the Federal Transit Act; and

WHEREAS, under Title 49 U.S.C. 5316, as amended by SAFETEA-LU, the County will be an eligible designated subrecipient; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation is submitting the application for FY 2014 and FY 2015 grant funding to the Maryland Transit Administration under provisions of the statute; and

WHEREAS, the County acknowledges that the United States Department of Transportation

requires, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, that in connection with the filing of an application for assistance under the Federal Transit Act, the applicant give an assurance that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the United States Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and

WHEREAS, the County acknowledges that the agreement between the County and the Maryland Transit Administration for a grant will impose certain obligations upon the County, including the contribution of the local share of the project costs; and

WHEREAS, the County states that it is the goal of the applicant that minority business enterprises be utilized to the fullest extent possible and that definite procedures shall be established and administered to ensure that minority businesses shall have the maximum opportunity to participate in construction contracts, supplies, equipment contracts or consultant and other services in connection with grant and financial assistance projects; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Transit Administration requires an approval resolution from the Prince George's County Council as a condition of awarding grant funding to the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the application submitted under Title 49 U.S.C. 5316, as amended by SAFETEA-LU – Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) and Section 5317 – New Freedom Programs under the Federal Transit Act is endorsed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive expresses support for the application submitted under Title 49 U.S.C. 5316, as amended by SAFETEA-LU- Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC) and Section 5317 – New Freedom Programs under the Federal Transit Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Council of Prince George's County is by endorsing this application indicating approval thereof; and that copies of this resolution be sent to the Maryland Transit Administration of the Maryland Department of Transportation.
