Sec. 16-147. Competitive n	nethods of filling vacant positions.	
(a) The Director of H	Iuman Resources Management may, in consultation with appointing	
authorities, utilize either of t	he following methods to authorize the competitive filling of a vacant	
position within the classified	service:	
(1) The certificat	ion of eligibles from a promotion register; or	
(2) The certificat	ion of eligibles from a recruitment register.	
(b) The Director of Hu	man Resources Management and any appointing authority shall give	

1	a ten (10%) preference or credit to county residents in the competitive filling of vacant positions
2	in the Prince George's County Government. In this section, "county resident" has the meaning
3	set forth in Section 10A-101(14.1) of the Code.
4	SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
5	calendar days after it becomes law.
