This Charter amendment bill was introduced on June 30, 2014 and was heard in Committee of the Whole on July 8, 2014.

The purpose of CB-51-2014 is to provide that immediately upon a vacancy in the Office of the County Executive; the Chief Administrative Officer shall become the acting County Executive until a County Executive is chosen by the methods established in Section 407 of the Charter.

If there is a vacancy in the first two years of a term, a special election is held. If there is a vacancy in the last two years of a term, Council selects from among its members for the balance of the term.

The bill was favorably voted out of the Committee of the Whole on July 8, 2014 by a vote of 8-0. (Campos absent)
