### REPORT:

Vote: Favorable, 8-0 (In favor: Council Members Franklin, Davis, Harrison, Lehman, Olson, Patterson, Toles and Turner; Absent: Council Members Campos.)

This charter amendment bill was introduced on June 30, 2014 and was heard in Committee of the Whole on July 8, 2014.

The bill proposes to change the number of designated newspapers of record from “three” to “one or more”

As drafted, the County is required to designate at minimum one primary source of County maintained electronic media available to the public for publication and transmission of official County notices.

The bill was voted favorable with recommended amendments out of the Committee of the Whole on July 8, 2014 by a vote of 8-0. (Campos absent)

### AMENDMENT TO CB-52-2014

As drafted, the County is required to designate at minimum one primary source of County maintained electronic media available to the public for publication and transmission of official County notices.

This amendment requires the County to designate two or more primary sources of County maintained electronic media available to the public for publication and transmission of official County notices.
