Committee Vote: Favorable, 3-0 (In favor: Council Members Franklin, Patterson, and Harrison)

Council staff summarized the purpose of the legislation and informed the committee of written referral comments that were received. CB-107-2012 repeals the enactment of Chapter 10, 2007 Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland. Staff also commented on the relationship of CB-107-2012 to a resolution, CR-81-2012, adopted by the County Council on October 16, 2012. The resolution was introduced and adopted in advance of CB-107-2012 to ensure expeditious repeal of the chapter in order to resolve pending litigation.

Council Member Franklin, the bill's sponsor, indicated that the legislation was introduced to address litigation matters associated with CB-18-2007 and Wilmer's Park.

The Office of Law reviewed CB-107-2012 and found it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment.
