17	(a) Where the Planning Board is authorized to conduct a public hearing in a zoning or site plan
18	case, the Planning Board shall <u>publish on its website</u> [send by first class mail] a copy of the
19	technical staff report [to the applicant and all parties of record] no less than two (2) weeks prior
20	to the scheduled public hearing on the application. Any person may request, in writing, a copy
21	of the technical staff report sent by first class mail. [At the same time and in the same manner,
22	the Planning Board shall send a copy of the technical staff report to every municipality located
23	within one (1) mile of the property which is the subject of the application and to all civic
24	associations registered with the Commission for the area which includes the property.] \underline{A}
25	reasonable fee may be charged to cover the costs of postage and copying. If new information is
26	provided by the applicant or any governmental agency after the technical staff report is
27	[completed] <u>published</u> , any party of record shall be allowed a one (1) week postponement if such
