Sec. 27-449. Extensions and projections.

- (a) General projections. (See Figure 55.)
- (1) No projections from building walls (including show windows, but not including signs) shall extend beyond building lines. (See Figure 55.)
- approved patio that is affixed to the side building wall of an Eating or Drinking Establishment and used as accessory patron seating for the use shall be permitted, provided that the use is located within the boundaries of an incorporated municipality, a temporary permit was previously granted for the usage of an affixed tent for such purposes, the affixed tent is approved by the Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement, and the usage of the affixed tent does not conflict with any applicable sector plan, master plan, or district development standards.
 - (b) Canopies. (See Figure 55.)
 - (1) Canopies may not extend beyond the building line along a street.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect on the
date of its adoption.
