Loans to A.M. Briggs, Inc., a subsidiary of Sysco Corporation ("A.M. Briggs"), from the		
Maryland Economic Development Assistance Fund ("MEDAF") and Prince George's County		
	Maryland (the "County")	
For the purpose of endorsing a loan not to exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to		
A.M. Briggs from the Maryland Department of Business and Economic Development's		
("DBED") MEDAF program which, in conjunction with the conditional loan from the County's		
Economic Development Incentive Fund ("EDI Fund") not to exceed eighty five thousand dollars		
(\$85,000), will be used for eligible project costs associated with a new facility in the County, and		
capital expenditu	ires.	
WHEREAS	S, the Maryland Department of Business and Economic Development ("DBED")	
and the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation ("EDC") have issued a		
joint proposal let	tter to Metropolitan Meat, Seafood and Poultry, Company, a division of A.M.	
Briggs, Inc., dated November 6, 2014, outlining a non-binding expression of intent to offer		
incentives for its expansion project, copy attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by		
reference, to pro-	vide a loan in an amount not to exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000)	
("the MEDAF L	oan"); and	
WHEREAS	S, the MEDAF Loan is authorized under the Maryland Economic Development	
Assistance Author	Assistance Authority and Fund ("MEDAAF") statute set forth in Sections 5-301 through 5-349	
of the Economic	Development Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended (the	
"Act"); and		

WHEREAS, the proceeds of the MEDAF Loan are expected to be used to reimburse A.M.

Briggs for eligible costs in connection with generally the following activities: (1) existing 126,732 square foot food distribution facility upgrade; and (2) construction, equipment, and ancillary costs; and

WHEREAS, it is expected that the project costs will total approximately five million three hundred sixty three thousand dollars (\$5,363,000) which will be funded by: (1) the MEDAF Loan; (2) a conditional loan not to exceed eighty five thousand dollars (\$85,000) (at least ten (percent (10%) match of the MEDAF Loan is required under Section 5-319(d)(2)(ii) of the Act), from the EDI Fund, (the "County Loan"); and (3) private financing and the owner's equity (the remaining funds); and

WHEREAS, it is expected that the term of the MEDAF Loan will be ten (10) years from the date of the disbursement, at an annual rate of three percent (3%) with payments of principal and accrued interest, which payments may be deferred or forgiven if A.M. Briggs employs at least two hundred thirty (230) full-time permanent employees for the term of the MEDAF Loan; and

WHEREAS, A.M. Briggs will initially employ at least one hundred fifty (150) full-time permanent employees at the Facility, employ two hundred fifteen (215) by June 30, 2016, and two hundred thirty (230) at the Facility by December 31, 2020; thereafter employing at least two hundred thirty (230) full-time permanent employees at the Facility for the remaining term of the MEDAF Loan; and

WHEREAS, under Sections 5-319(d)(1) and (2)(ii) of the Act, a formal resolution of the governing body of the County is required to endorse the MEDAF Loan; and

WHEREAS, the County Council and the County Executive have determined, based upon the finding and determinations set forth herein, that it is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the County that the County Executive and County Council endorse the MEDAF Loan, as set forth in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Prince George's County Code Sec. 10-287, notice of intent to award financial assistant from the EDI Fund was provided to the County Council on August 25, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council and County Executive of Prince George's County, Maryland, the recitals in the WHEREAS clauses to this Resolution are hereby incorporated herein by reference and deemed a substantive part of this Resolution.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the loan from MEDAF to A.M. Briggs in an amount not to exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) as set forth in Exhibit "A" or any revision thereof is hereby endorsed by the County Council and the County Executive.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of the County's conditional loan to A.M. Briggs in an amount not to exceed eighty five thousand dollars (\$85,000) from the EDI Fund on substantially the same terms and conditions of the MEDAF Loan was provided.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive or his designee are hereby authorized and empowered to execute on behalf of the County such documents, instruments and certificates as are necessary or appropriate to consummate the MEDAF Loan and the County Loan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective as of the date of its adoption.
