BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

The 2008 Water and Sewer Plan provides for three cycles of category change requests annually to amend the Plan. This Resolution represents the December 2014 Cycle of Amendments.

The 2008 Water and Sewer Plan was adopted by CR-91-2008, and amended by CR-17-2009, CR-52-2009, CR-5-2010, CR-19-2010, CR-82-2010, CR-20-2011, CR-4-2012, CR-19-2012, CR-27-2012, CR-71-2012, CR-20-2013, CR-50-2013, CR-92-2013, CR-11-2014 and CR-57-2014. The December 2014 Cycle contains three (3) requests for a category change.

One (1) category change request is in the Parkway sewershed, one (1) is in the Western Branch sewershed, and one (1) is in the Piscataway sewershed.

Additionally, the Department of the Environment (DoE) has requested to amend certain subdivided residential lots to reflect public water and sewer service designations and to remove septic system symbols from corresponding water and sewer maps. These amendment requests are located within Council Districts 1, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 9.

Environment Article, Title 9, Subtitle 5, of the Maryland Annotated Code, sets procedures for amendments and revisions to the Plan. At least 30 days prior to the public hearing on the amendments, the County Council must submit to the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission and Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission a copy of the resolution for their recommendations.
