




#### Percent of Adults by Weight, 2014


### Birth Outcomes: PGC Infant Mortality Rate


## PGC Low Birth Weight Infants (<2500g)




## HIV: PGC New HIV Case Rate (Ages 13+)


### Safe Physical Environment: PGC Homicide Rate
