For the purpose of authorizing the Director of the Prince George's County Department of Public				
Works and Transportation to file an application for Fiscal Year 2017 with the Maryland Transit				
Administration of the Maryland Department of Transportation for certain grants under the				
Statewide Special Transportation Assistance Program ("SSTAP") and the Federal Transit Act.				
WHEREAS, the Maryland Transit Administration is the designated recipient in Maryland				
for grants under the Federal Transit Act; and				
WHEREAS, the Administrator of the Maryland Transit Administration is authorized to				
make grants to counties and to local governments for mass transportation programs and/or				
projects; and				
WHEREAS, an application for financial assistance imposes certain obligations upon the				
applicant, which includes a local share of costs for certain projects and/or programs; and				
WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation, in accordance with the				
provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, requires an applicant for assistance under				
the Federal Transit Act to give assurances that it will comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights				
Act of 1964 and the United States Department of Transportation requirements thereunder; and				
WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Department of Public Works and Transportation				
will submit an application to the Maryland Transit Administration for financial assistance under				
the SSTAP to support the County's mass transportation program; and				
WHEREAS the County: (1) gives to utilize minority business enterprises to the fullest				

WHEREAS, the County: (1) aims to utilize minority business enterprises to the fullest extent possible in connection with the programs and/or projects listed in the County's

4	Maryland Transit Administration requires the governing body of Prince George's County, by		
5	resolution, to authorize the filing of the aforesaid application.

7	County, Maryland, that the filing of the aforesaid application for Fiscal Year 2017 be endorsed.

9	requested to endorse this resolution, thereby indicating approval thereof.		
10	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution shall be sent to the Maryland		
11	Transit Administration of the Maryland Department of Transportation.
