issuance of a building permit for a building or other structure on such lot, subject to the following conditions:

(1) The use of such lot shall be restricted to one-family detached dwellings or agricultural uses, and structures and uses accessory thereto , unless it is an adaptive reuse of an existing building containing no more than 10,000 square feet of gross floor area situated on a lot or parcel with land area not exceeding 1 acre used by an eleemosynary or philanthropic institution providing temporary emergency shelter, family, and/or social services for survivors of domestic violence and their families in the R-R (Rural Residential) Zone;
