Case Name: Westphalia Central Park - Phase I, Parkside

Location: The subject SDP includes the entire Westphalia Central Park that is located in the

eastern quadrant of the intersection of Central Park Drive (MC-631) and P-615, in an irregular shape of a goldfish with a long tail. The two roadways intersect in the front and to the west of the Central Park, in the middle of the larger Parkside project

site. Another master plan roadway, MC-632, divides the entire park in the

north/south direction from the middle into distinct eastern and western parts. The

proposed Phase I is located in the western part (131 Acres; R-M Zone).

Request: Requesting approval of a Specific Design Plan for the Westphalia Central Park, as

required by Condition 23 attached to the previously approved Comprehensive

Design Plan, CDP-0501.
