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60 Provided the use is on property with a land area of at least five (5) acres. <u>Notwithstanding any other provision within Section 27-471 of this Subtitle to the contrary, a</u> <u>Private Limousine Service Dispatching Station use situated on five (5) or more acres of land where a business was operating within the definition of 'Private Limousine Service Dispatching Station' set forth in Section 27-107.01 of this Subtitle, and for which no new development requiring a County building permit is proposed, shall be a permitted use and shall only conform with the requirements set forth in Section 27-471 of this subtitle if development to expand the use requires a County building permit.</u>

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect on the
date of its adoption.
