12	(d) [The fee for each special food service facility - mobile unit license is Three Hundred

15	[(e) The Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement shall make available a
16	thirty (30) day special food service facility - mobile unit license at a fee of \$100 for an applicant
17	who will only operate at a temporary special event, fair, or festival for a limited time.]
18	Sec. 5-2804. License application.
19	(a) All applicants for a special food service facility - mobile unit license shall file an
20	application for such license on forms provided by the Department of Permitting, Inspections, and
21	Enforcement. All principal owners shall be named in the application form.
22	(b) The completed application shall contain, but is not limited to, the following
23	information and shall be accompanied by the following documents:
24	[(1) If the applicant is:]
25	[(A) An individual, the individual shall state his or her legal name and
26	any aliases, shall submit their mailing address and residential address, telephone number;]
27	[(B) A partnership, the partnership shall state its complete name, the
28	names of all partners, the mailing address and residential address of all partners, whether the
29	partnership is general or limited, and a copy of the partnership agreement, if any;]
30	[(C) A corporation, the corporation shall state its complete name, its
31	mailing address and residential address, information regarding the resident agent, the date of its
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- incorporation, evidence that the corporation is in good standing under the statutes of the State, or in the case of a foreign corporation, evidence that it is currently authorized to do business in the State, the names and capacity of all officers, directors and principal owners, and the name of the registered corporate agent and the address of the registered office for service of process;]
- [(D) A limited liability company shall state its complete name, its mailing address and residential address, the names of all managers and members.]
- [(2) At the time of special food service facility mobile unit license renewal, applicants shall submit proof that all applicable operating taxes have been paid for the prior tax year.] (1) All applicants shall provide a copy of their Federal Employer Identification Number and evidence of Combined Central Registration with the Maryland Comptroller's Office.
- [(3) Whether the applicant or any individual listed under subsection (a) of this Section has worked under, or currently works under, a special food service facility mobile unit license under any ordinance from this State, another state, municipality or county which has been denied, suspended or revoked, including the name and location of the business for which the special food service facility mobile unit license was denied, suspended or revoked, as well as the date of the denial, suspension or revocation.]
- [(4)] (2) The location of the food truck hub(s) where the special food service facility mobile unit license holder intends to operate including the street address and telephone number(s), if known.
 - [(5)] (3) A description of the type of food offered for sale.
 - [(6)] (4) Description of the vehicle, including a color photograph of the vehicle.
 - [(7)] (5) A copy of the vehicle registration.
- [(8)] (6) A photocopy of the driver's license or other government issued identification card for the individuals listed in subsection (a) of this Section.
- [(9)] (7) The applicant shall provide any and all additional information requested by the Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement.
- (c) [If the applicant is an individual, he/she must sign the application for a special food service facility mobile unit license. If the applicant is a corporation it must be signed by the president or vice president and attested to by the secretary or assistant secretary. If the applicant is a general or limited partnership it must be signed by a general partner. If the applicant is a limited liability company it must be signed by the manager.]

- [(d)] If an omission or error is discovered by the Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement, the application will be returned to the applicant for completion or correction without further action by the Departmental of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement. Any application rejected due to an omission or error shall be accepted only when the omission or error has been remedied. For purposes of this Division, the date that the Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement accepts an application which is complete shall be the date the application is accepted by the Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement.
- [(e)] (d) In the event that the Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement determines that an applicant has improperly completed the application, it shall promptly notify the applicant and allow the applicant thirty (30) days to properly complete the application. The time period for granting or denying a special food service facility mobile unit license shall be stayed during the period in which the applicant is allowed an opportunity to properly complete the application.
- [(f)] (e) Applicants for a special food service facility mobile unit license under this Division and license holders shall have a continuing duty to promptly supplement application information required by this Section in the event that said information changes in any way from what is stated on the application. The failure to comply with said continuing duty within thirty (30) days from the date of such change, by supplementing the application of file with the Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement, shall be grounds for the suspension or revocation of a special food service facility mobile unit license.

Sec. 5-2806. [Insurance Requirement.]

- (a) Each licensee shall file with Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement a copy of his/her insurance policy covering the special food service facility mobile unit.
- [(b) Department of Permitting, Inspections, and Enforcement may specify through regulations what policies and levels of coverage are necessary.]
