BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

Section 811 of the Charter and Section 10-106 of the County Code requires that following adoption of the Current Expense Budget, the Council by resolution shall set the County tax levy. Shown below are the real and personal property tax rates for the County, the State and Stormwater for FY 2016 and FY 2017. The State of Maryland real property tax rate is eleven and twenty hundredths cents (0.1120 cents) per \$100 of assessed value. Similarly, the State tax rate for public utilities is twenty-eight cents (\$0.28) per \$100 assessed value. Both remain the same in FY2017 as they were in FY2016.
