Provided that, for an existing Food or Beverage Store with no more than 2,000 square feet of gross floor area devoted to retail sales with a valid Class A beer, wine, and liquor license issued by the Board of License Commissioners for Prince George's County pursuant to Title 26, Alcoholic Beverages Article, Annotated Code of Maryland before July 1, 2016, said existing Food or Beverage Store may perform interior and exterior renovations to improve and/or expand the facility by an area not to exceed 20 percent of the existing square footage of the current enclosed area, and such improvements may be constructed pursuant to the building standards and permit requirements applicable to the site at the time of issuance of the initial use and occupancy permit for the use.
