CB-065-2016 is a Bill to amend the Property Standards Code Enforcement Officer and Property Standards Inspector class series. This amendment is the result of a classification study which shows the Property Standards Inspector class should be assigned to higher grades.

During the Committee review, Valerie Farrar from the Office of Human Resources provided an overview of the bill and shared the results of the Classification Study.

There are approximately 63 employees in this class series. Of the 63 employees, 44 would get an increase in their base pay.

The Office of Law reports CB-065-2016 to be in proper legal form with no impediments to its enactment.

The Office of Audits and Investigations reports that CB-065-2016 will have a negative impact on the County of \$120,938.

After discussion the Public Safety and Fiscal Management Committee voted CB-065-2016 out favorably 3-0.
