CR-003-2017 FY 2017-2026 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan

Pursuant to your request, we have reviewed CR-003-2017 to estimate its fiscal impact on Prince George's County, Maryland.

CR-003-2017 will adopt the County's FY 2017-2026 Comprehensive Ten Year Solid Waste Management Plan (the "Plan) as required by Title 9, Subtitle 5 of the Environment Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland. The Plan sets forth a program to meet the County's needs for solid waste collection, disposal, and recycling over the next ten years, addressing State and local requirements. The proposed Resolution also repeals the County's FY 2012-2022 Ten Year Solid Waste Plan.

Adoption of CR-003-2017 should not have an adverse fiscal impact on Prince George's County.
