PROPOSED USES DISCUSSED IN MODULE 1/COMPARISON TO CURRENT ZONING ORDINANCE

Derick Berlage, Chief, Countywide Planning Division Chad Williams, Project Manager Brittney Drakeford, M-NCPPC Bryan Barnett-Woods and Susan Laruese, M-NCPPC, facilitated a PowerPoint presentation on Uses and Use Tables proposed within the rewrite, which focused on organization of the use tables, use consolidation, special exceptions and use-specific standards and new uses and interpretations. They and other the other panel guests responded to questions regarding: definitions, rationale for blanks within the table, principle uses versus sub-categories, accessory uses, multiple uses on a property, correlation to language in the Annotate Code of Maryland, telecommunications regulations, houses of worship, mental health facilities, personal service uses, wayside stands, food truck hubs, partitioning of single-family homes, treatment centers, convention centers, home-based businesses, grandfathering of parcels that have been transitioned to a new use, non-conforming uses, anti-blight clause, use consolidation, bed and breakfast use, eating and drinking establishments, crematories, air bnb uses/function, contractors, freestanding spas versus hotel spa, beauty shop and barber shop, adult uses versus night clubs, banquet halls, use specific standards, use variances, text amendments, importance of legislative history, approval process, current process for interpreting new uses, role of Planning Director and regional comparisons.
