SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland,				
that Sections 29-128 and 29-131 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same are hereby				
repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:				

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# SUBTITLE 29. PRESERVATION OF HISTORIC RESOURCES. DIVISION 9. HISTORIC AGRICULTURAL RESOURCE PRESERVATION PROGRAM.

### Sec. 29-128. Applicability.

The HARPP program shall be available to all land zoned O-S, R-A, R-E or R-R in <u>, or adjacent to, land that is located outside of the County's approved Growth Policy Boundary area and is within the Rural Tier.</u> Any conservation easement acquired under the HARPP program shall be voluntarily offered by the landowner.

#### Sec. 29-131. Eligibility Criteria.

(a) A parcel must meet the following criteria to be eligible to participate in the program: the parcel must be zoned O-S, R-A, R-E or R-R and located in , or adjacent to, land that is located outside of the County's approved Growth Policy Boundary area and is within the Rural Tier; privately owned; the parcel shall be capable of being further developed; include a minimum of thirty-five (35) acres with no more than one (1) single family dwelling; include a minimum of twenty (20) acres with no more than one (1) single family dwelling and be contiguous to property held as a public park or preserve or property otherwise permanently protected from development by easement or otherwise.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five
