
Our employees are your community members.





LEGEND CY16 Patients 199 and below 200 to 479 480 to 799 800 to 1,099 1,100 to 1,799 1,800 and above





Case Study: Average Daily Census (example NICU)



Increased ADC

- Higher acuity patients remain in the local community
- Fewer complications; fewer transfers out
- Initial Decrease in LOS
 - Improved efficiency with patient population
- Later Increase in LOS
 - Increased capability in local NICU
 - 23-24 week infants (4-6 month hospital course)
 - Higher acuity patients
 - Fewer complications means patients stay in home NICU for entire hospital stay
