Sec. 26-122 Parking for longer than twenty four	[seventy-two] hours prohibited.	
(a) [No person shall park or allow to stand any v	ehicle on any of the public streets or	
roadways in the County for a period in excess of seven	enty-two (72) hours.] The parking of motor	
vehicles and trailers upon the public highways, roads	, and streets in the County for a period	
longer than twenty-four (24) hours is hereby prohibit	ed; except when not otherwise prohibited	
adjacent to property lines of owner's residence or bu	siness.	

1	(b) Any person issued a citation for a violation of this Section shall be subject to a fine of		
2	Two-Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) [Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)] for each violation.		
3	SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)		
4	calendar days after it becomes law.
