Notwithstanding any other provision within Section 27-471 of this Subtitle to the contrary, a Private Limousine Service Dispatching Station use situated on [five (5)] three (3) or more acres of land where a business was operating within the definition of 'Private Limousine Service Dispatching Station' set forth in Section 27-107.01 of this Subtitle as of November 1, 2015, and for which no [new development requiring a County building permit] expansion of the use is proposed, shall be a permitted use and shall only conform with the requirements set forth in Section 27-471 of this subtitle if development to expand the use requires a County building permit.
