RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Juneteenth National Freedom Day Observance

For the purpose of expressing support for the Juneteenth National Freedom Day Observance and Celebration.

WHEREAS, approximately eleven and a half million African-Americans survived the "Middle Passage," a month-long voyage across the Atlantic Ocean stacked in the bottom of slave ships and were subjected to more than 200 years of slavery upon arrival in the United States; and

WHEREAS, more than two and a half years after the Emancipation Proclamation was signed by President Abraham Lincoln on September 22, 1862, Major General Gordon Granger issued General Order Number 3, on June 19, 1865, declaring that, in accordance with the Emancipation Proclamation, all enslaved people were free with an "absolute equality of rights and rights of property between former masters and those enslaved"; and

WHEREAS, Juneteenth, or June 19, is celebrated each year as the date when the last enslaved people in the United States were freed and commemorates the spontaneous celebration that erupted among African-Americans upon learning of their freedom; and

WHEREAS, after more than 150 years of its annual celebration, Juneteenth has been officially recognized by the President and the Congress of the United States as Juneteenth Independence Day; and

WHEREAS, Americans of all colors, creeds, cultures, religions and countries of origin share a common love of and respect for freedom, as well as a determination to protect their right to freedom through democratic institutions, by which the tenets of freedom are guaranteed and protected. The nineteenth of June, or "Juneteenth Independence Day," coupled with

1 Independence Day on the fourth of July, completes the "cycle of freedom" for America's 2 Independence Day observances; and 3 WHEREAS, the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland has expressed support yearly for the National Juneteenth Holiday Campaign; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the General Assembly of Maryland enacted legislation during the 2014 6 Legislative Session requiring the Governor annually to proclaim June 19 as Juneteenth National 7 Freedom Day; and 8 WHEREAS, Juneteenth National Freedom Day, which recalls how slaves hated slavery and 9 celebrated its abolishment with excitement and great joy, serves as a reminder to all Americans of the status and importance of Americans of African descent. 10 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's 12 County, Maryland, that Prince George's County hereby expresses support for Juneteenth 13 National Freedom Day. 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council hereby supports Juneteenth celebrations 15 held in Prince George's County and applauds the participation of employees, families and communities in the observance held on June 17, 2017 at Walker Mill Regional Park. 16 Adopted this 13th day of June, 2017.
