ORDER CERTIFYING A NONCONFORMING USE

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, after review of the administrative record, that the

application for certification of a nonconforming use for an automotive repair facility with four

service bays and an automobile parking compound which is comprised of 0.50 acre of land in the

R-T (Townhouse) and T-D-O (Transit-District-Overlay) Zone, identified as 6125 Old Central

Avenue, Capitol Heights, Maryland, is hereby APPROVED.

As the basis for this final decision, and as expressly authorized by the Land Use Article

of the Annotated Code of Maryland, and the Prince George's County Code, Subtitle 27, the

District Council adopts the findings and conclusions of the Planning Board, as embodied in

Resolution PGCPB No. 16-141.

The automotive repair facility with four service bays and an automobile parking

compound which is comprised of 0.50 acre of land in the R-T (Townhouse) and T-D-O (Transit-

District-Overlay) Zone, identified as 6125 Old Central Avenue, Capitol Heights, Maryland, shall

be declared to be a Certified Non-Conforming Use in accordance with the findings of facts and

conclusions in PGCPB No. 16-141, subject to the following condition:

1. The Applicant shall replace all existing array of fence types on the subject property with a six-foot-high sight-tight fence in

order to reduce any adverse impact of the parking area on the

adjacent single-family residential uses. Materials for the sixfoot-high sight-tight fence shall be engineered or composite

treated wood. The color of the six-foot-high sight-tight fence shall compliment the color of the subject property and adjacent

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single-family residential neighborhood. The Applicant shall not be permitted to install a chain link fence to satisfy this condition.

2. Any violation of the conditions of this approval shall be subject to revocation proceedings in accordance with the Prince George's County Code.
