REPORT: Favorable 5-0 (In Favor: Council Members Glaros, Harrison, Lehman, Taveras, and Turner.

CR-51-2017 is a Resolution providing supplementary appropriations of \$10 million for the Suitland capital project. The Resolution also amends the FY 2017–FY2022 Capital Improvement Plan Program of the Revenue Authority of Prince George's County.

Funding for this Resolution will come from a transfer from the County's General Fund. The funds will be used for on-going land acquisition efforts to revitalize the Suitland community.

Amber Hendricks, Deputy, Office of Budget and Management, provided an overview of the proposed Resolution.

The Office of Law reports CR-51-2017 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The Office of Audits and Investigations reports that enactment of CR-51-2017 will have a positive fiscal impact of \$10 million on the County's Capital Improvement Program. However, funds in the amount of \$10 million will no longer be available for General Fund purposes.

After discussion, the Public Safety and Fiscal Management Committee reported our CR-51-2017 out favorably 5-0.
